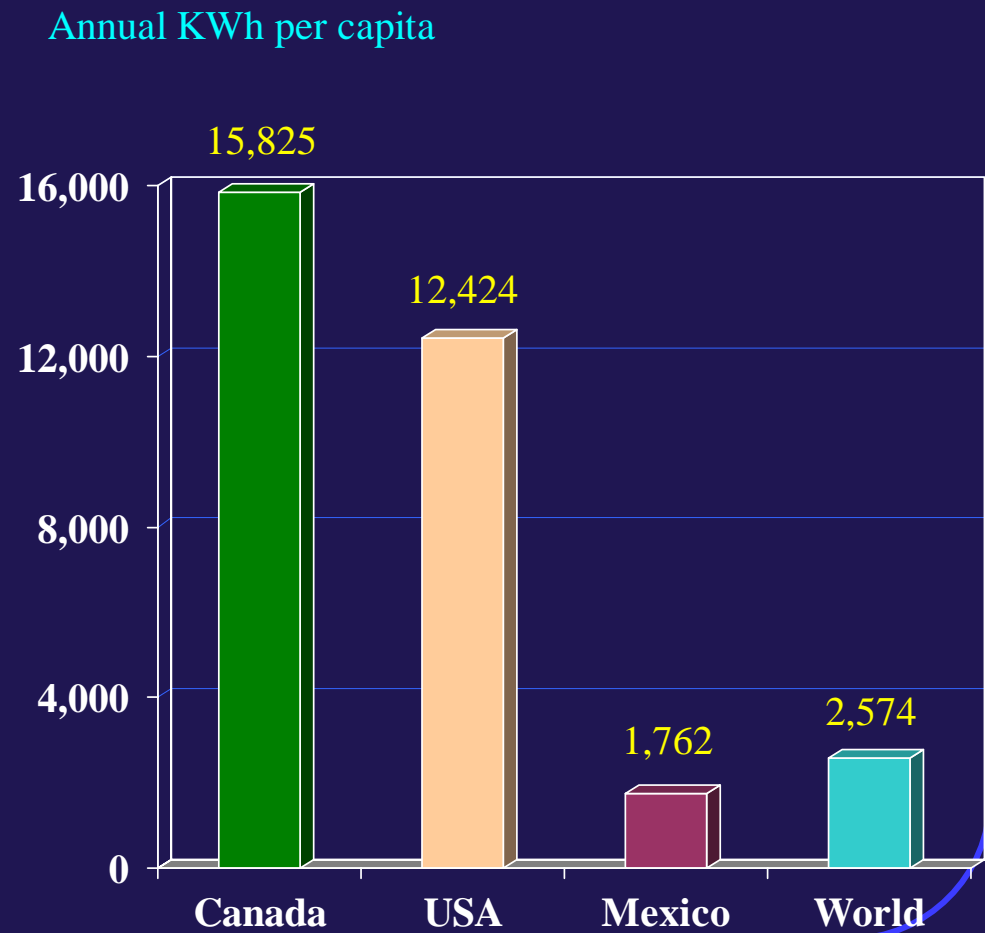
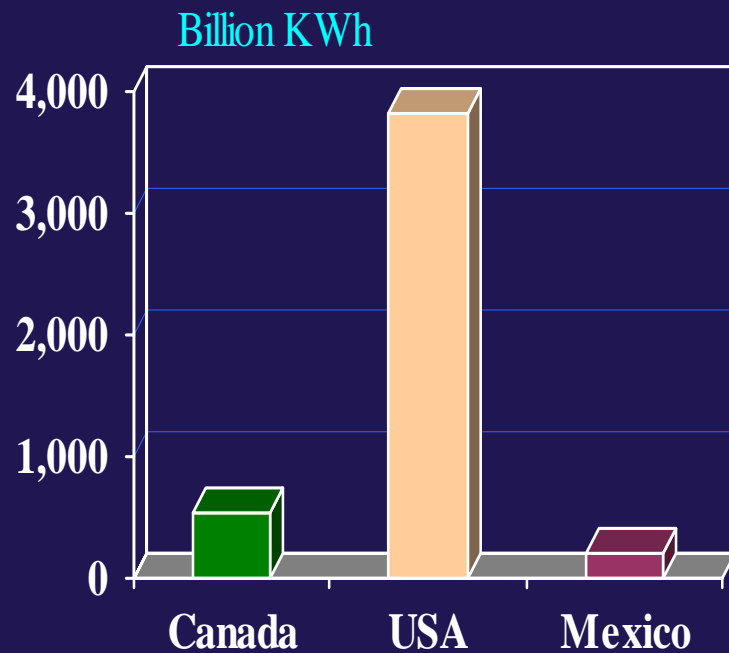
Electricity 2006 Consumption & Generation



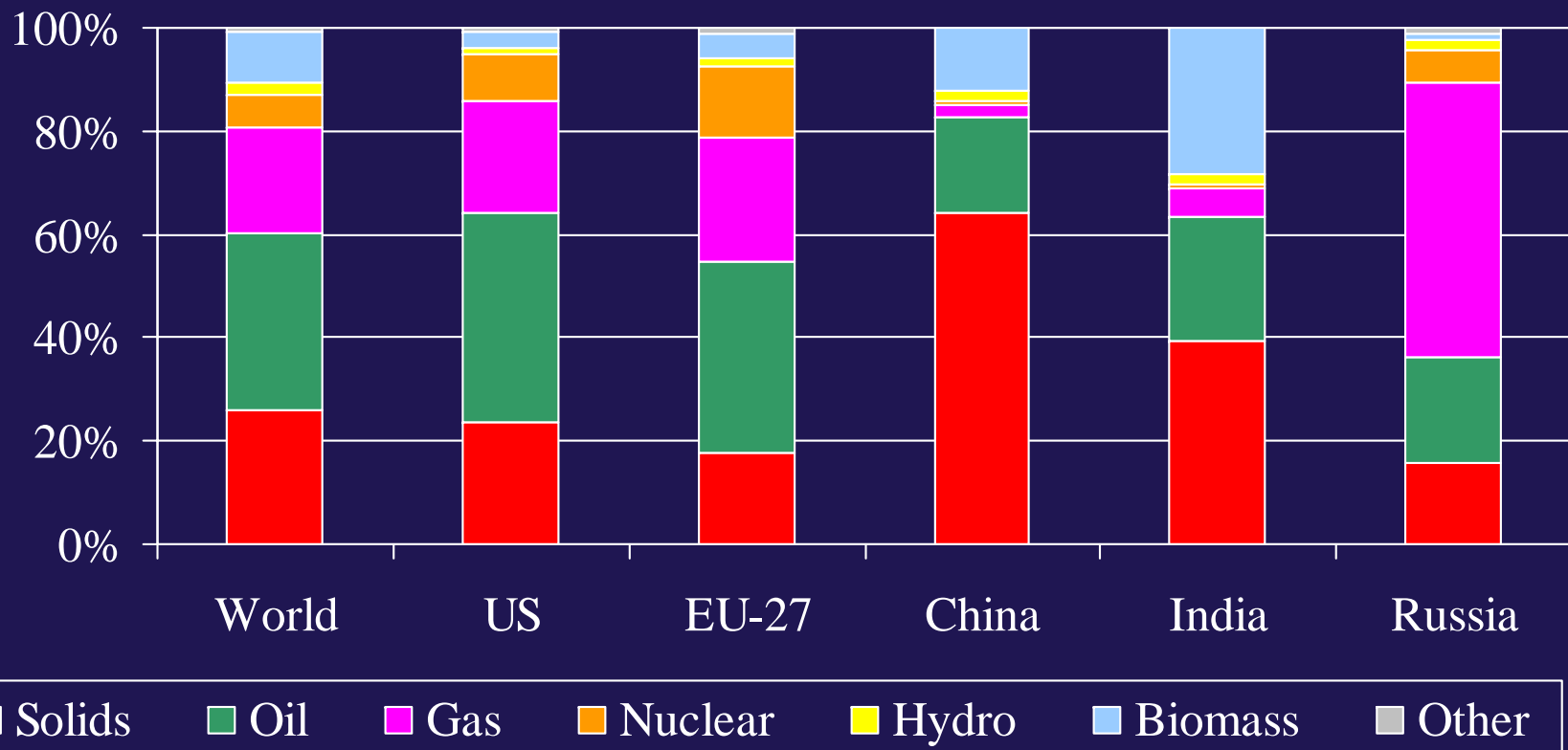

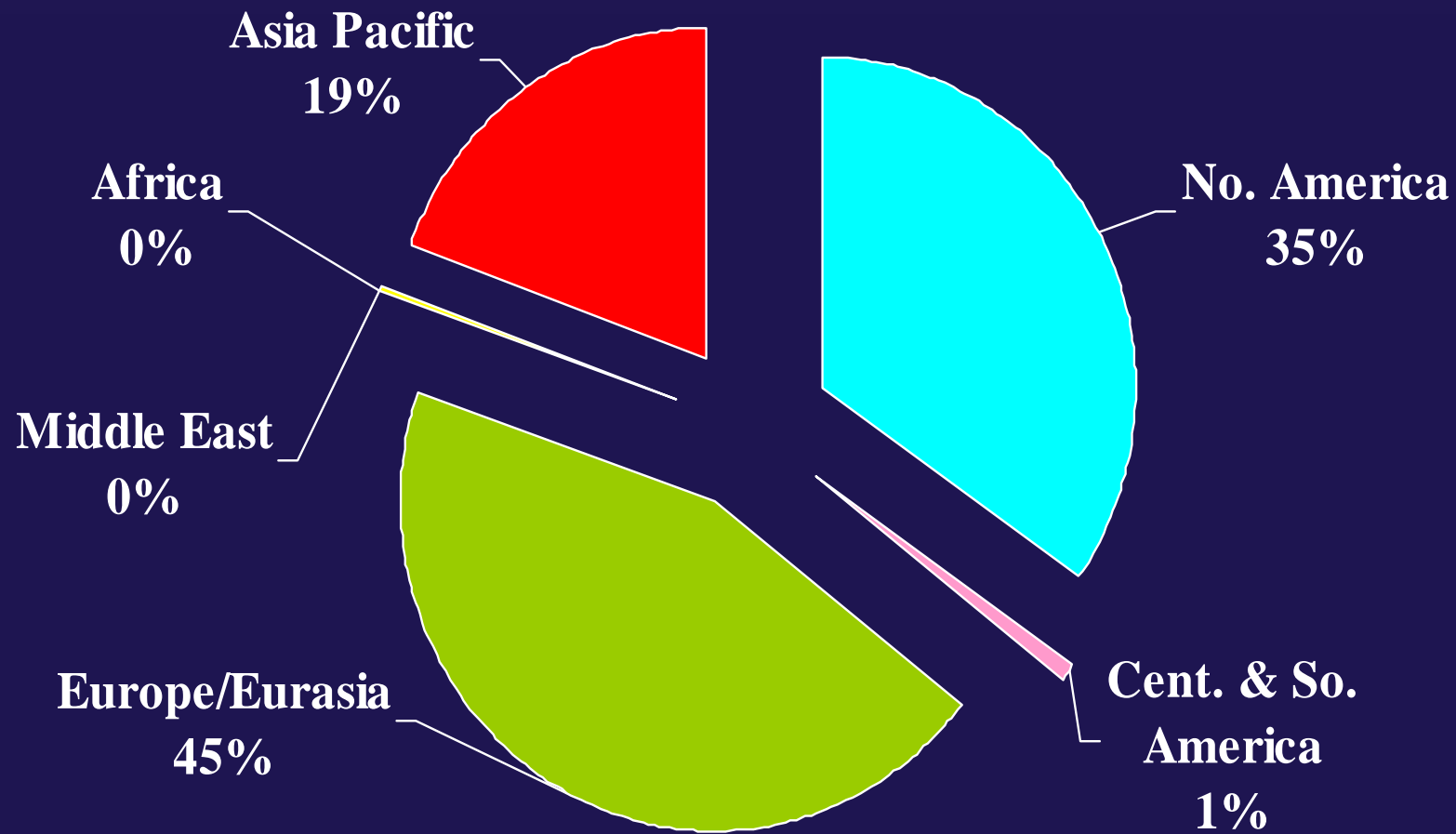

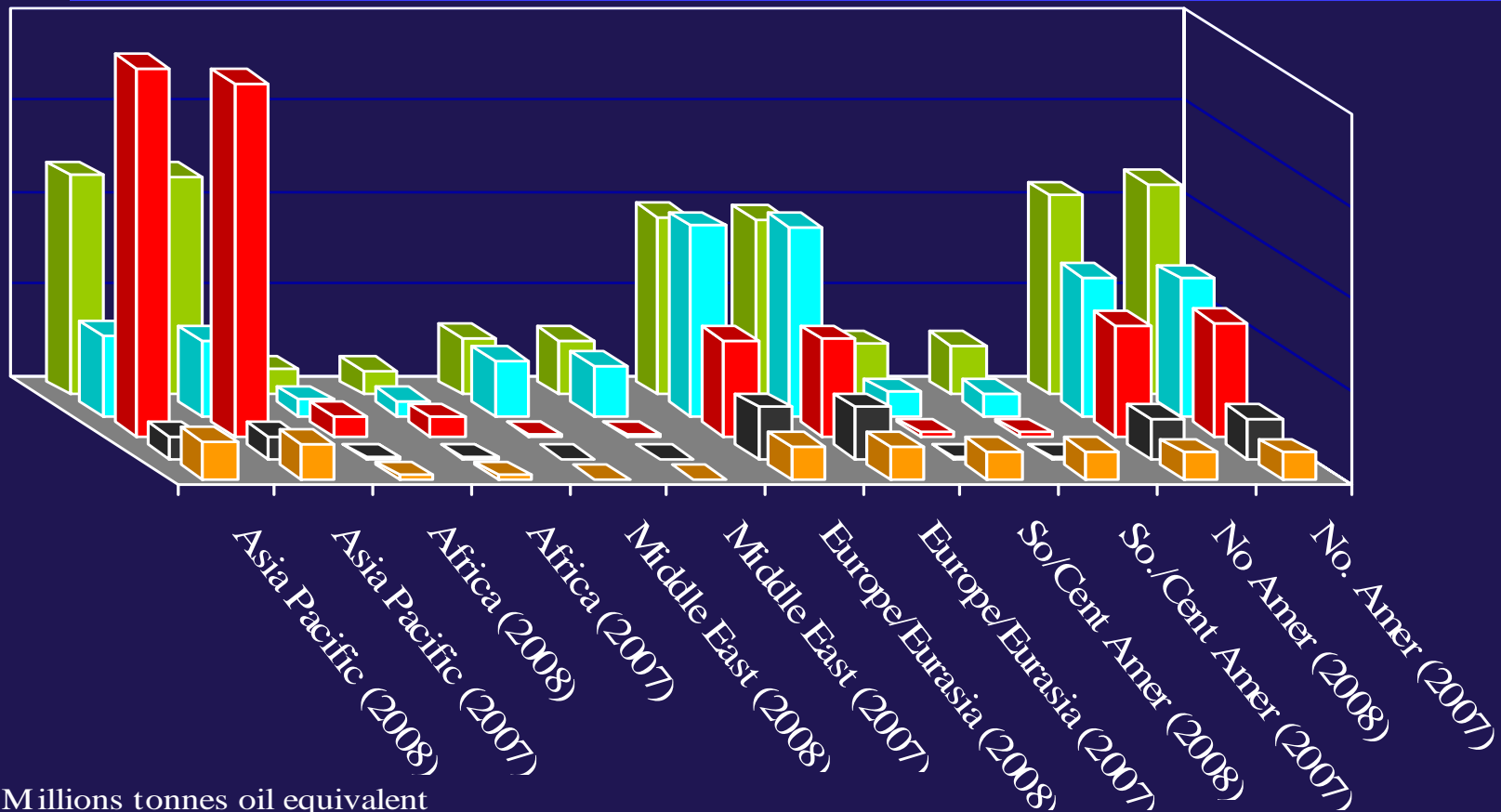
2006 Energy Consumption by Fuel (Gross Inland Consumption)

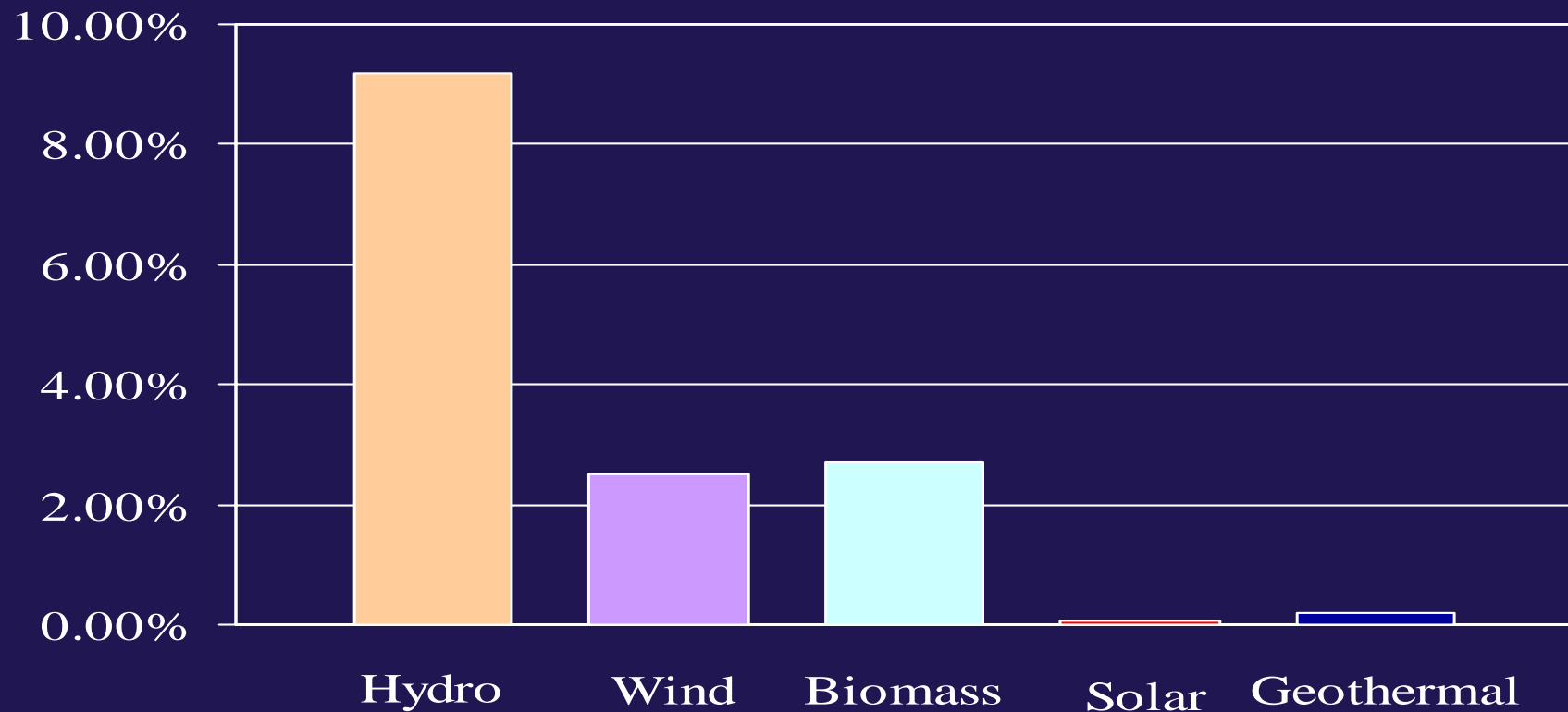

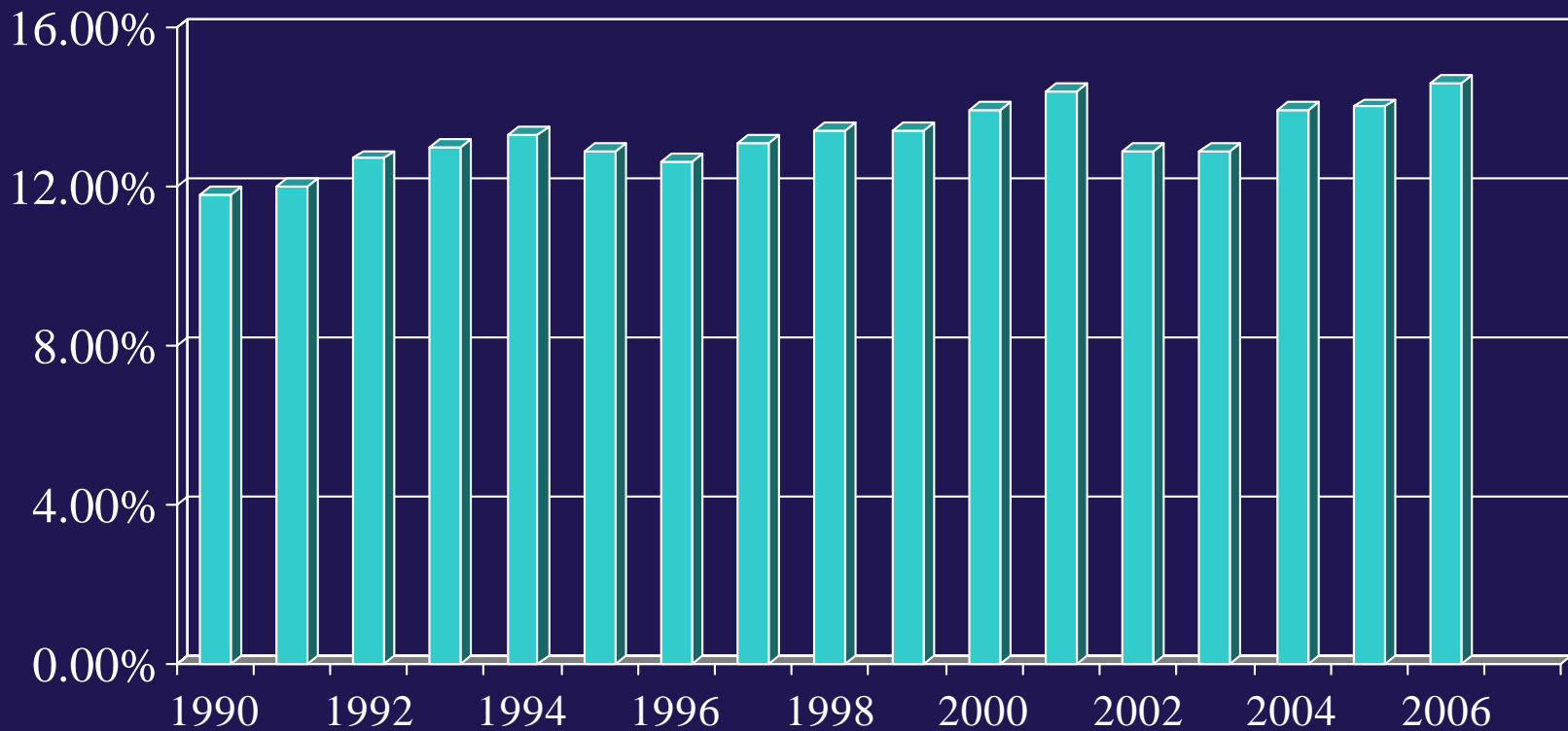

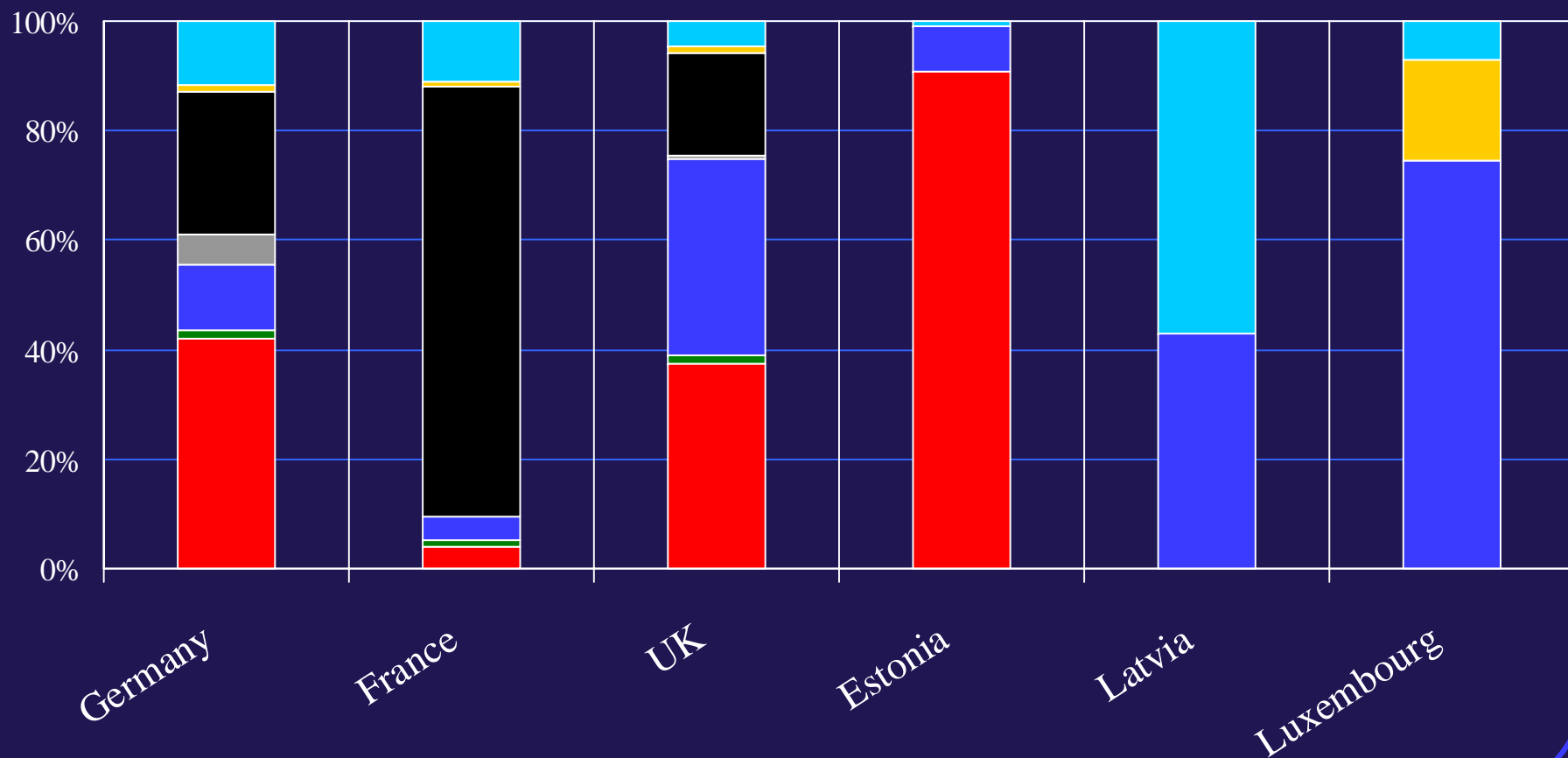
Percent of 2006 Gross Electricity Consumption from Renewable Sources (EU 27)



Percent of Gross Electricity Consumption from Renewable Sources (EU 27)

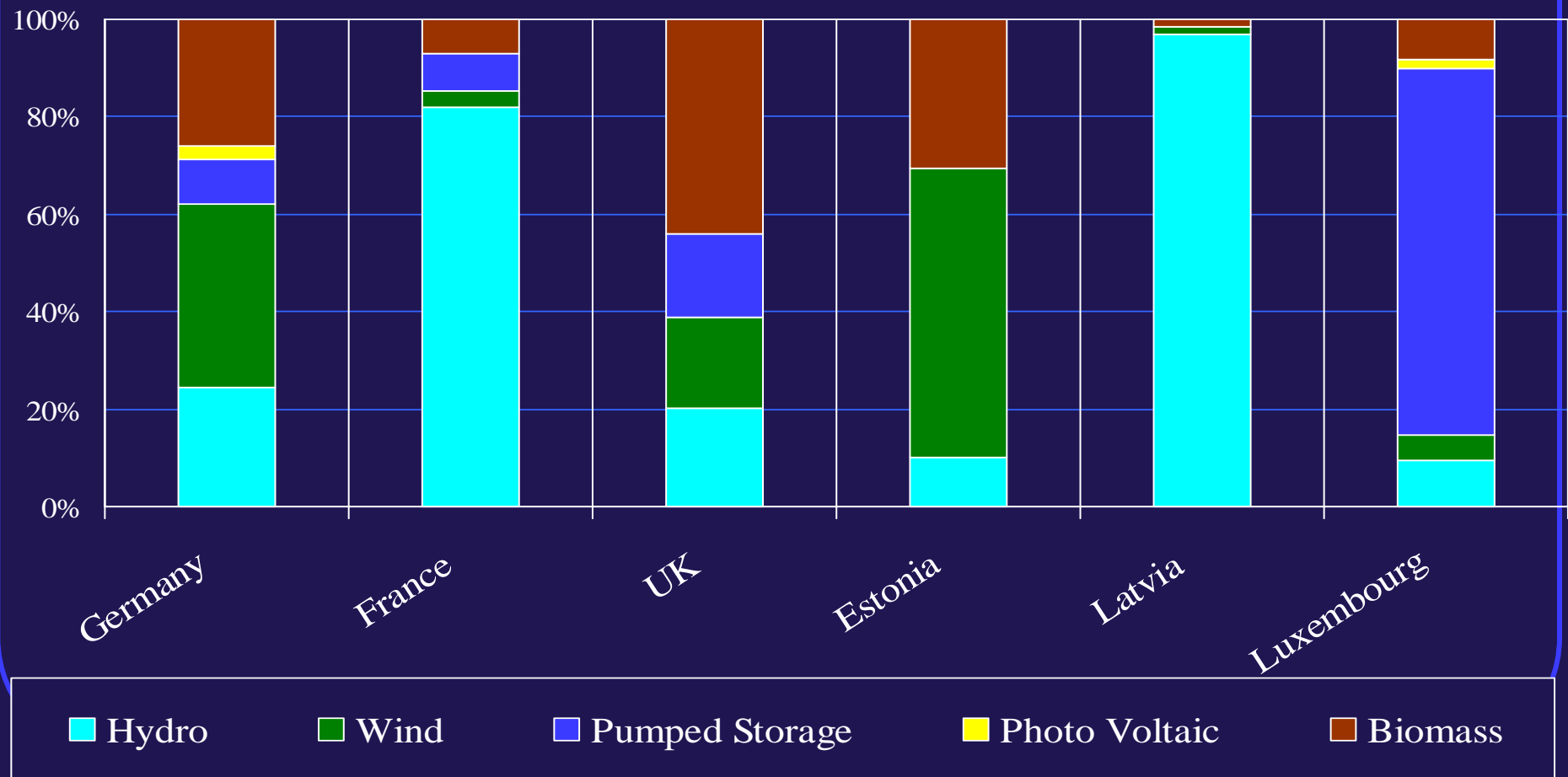


2006 Gross Electricity by Source (GWh)

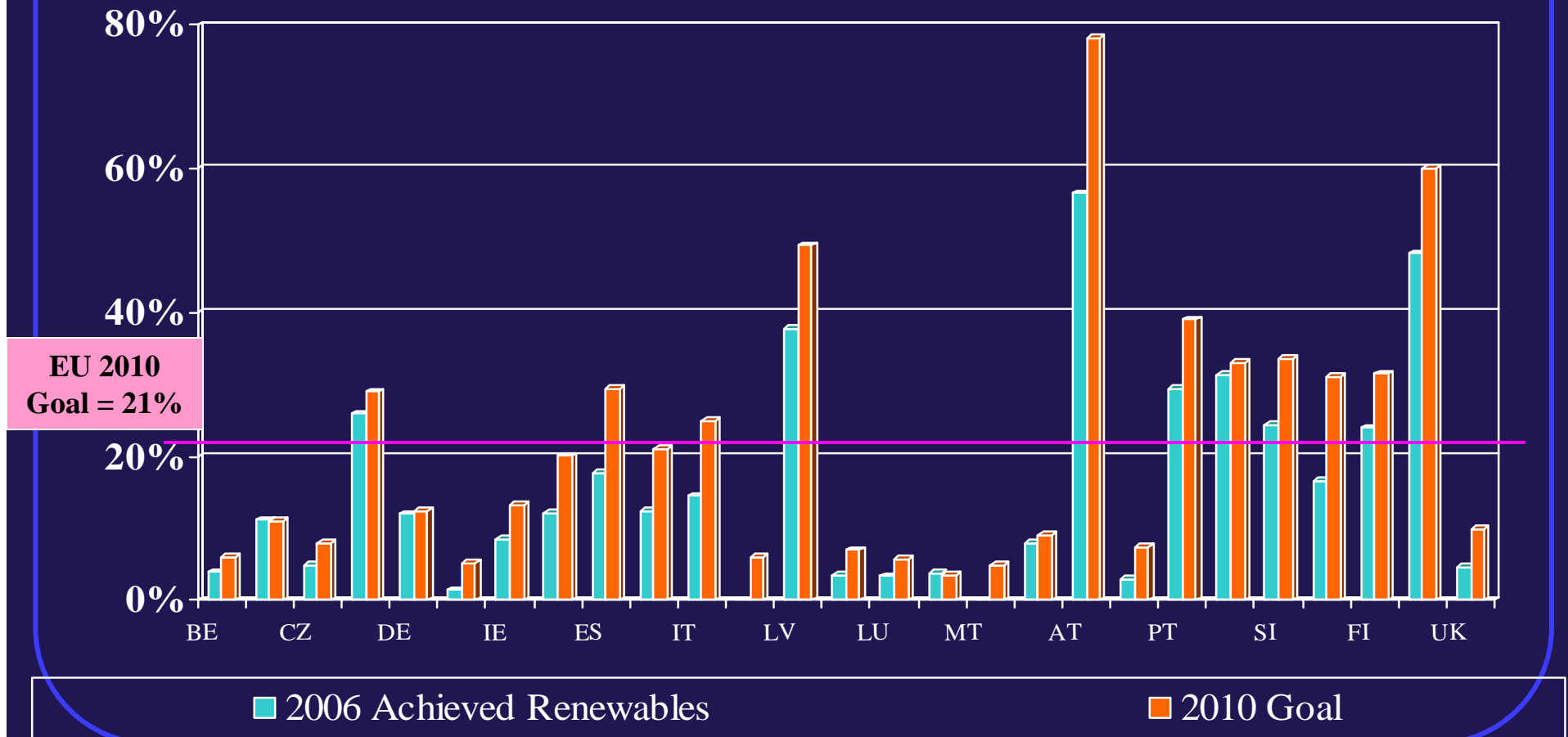


Coal Oil Gas Other Power Stations Nuclear Pumped Storage Renewables

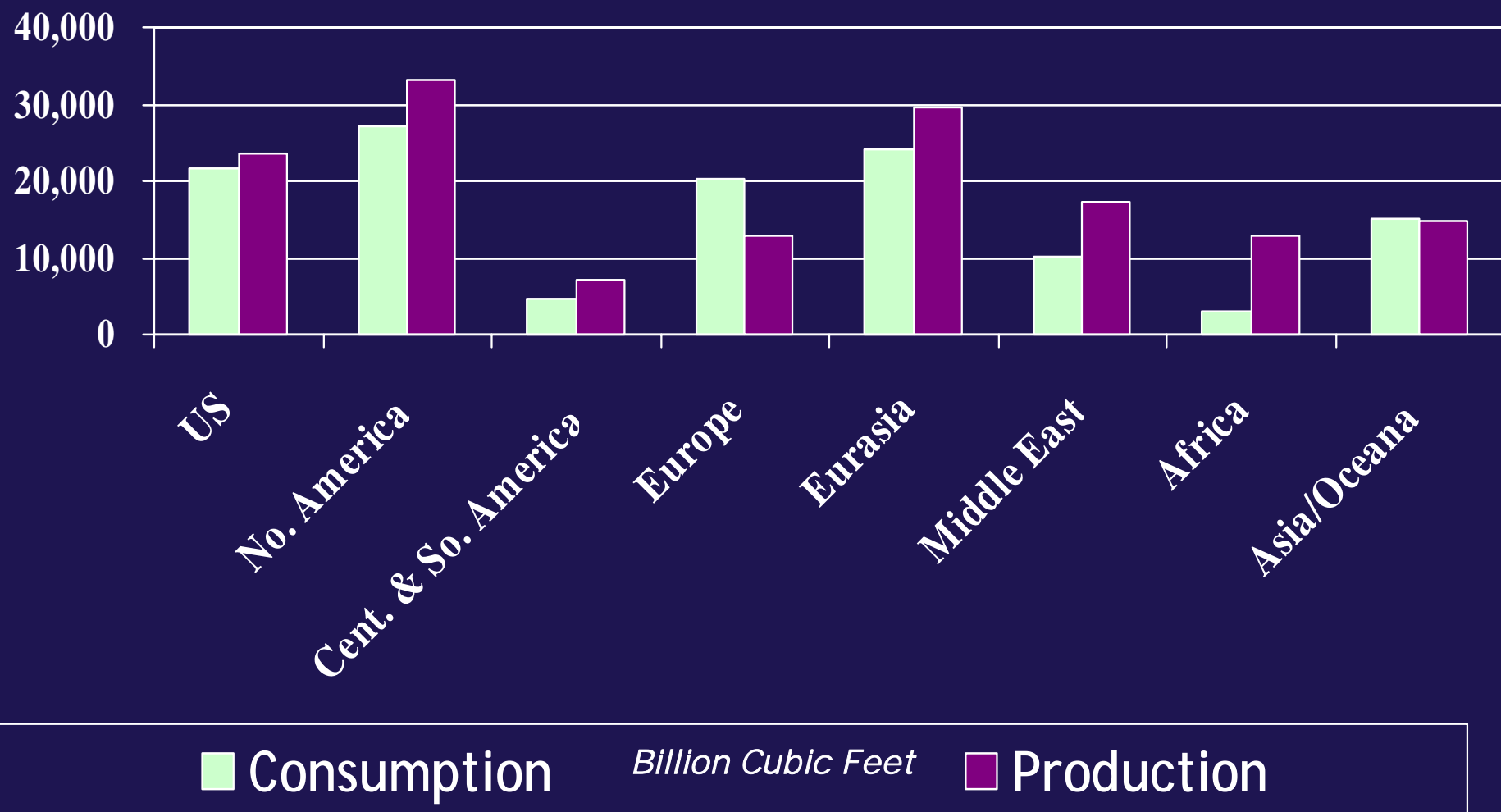
2006 Renewables by Type (GWh)



2006 Achieved Renewables vs 2010 Goals (EU-27)

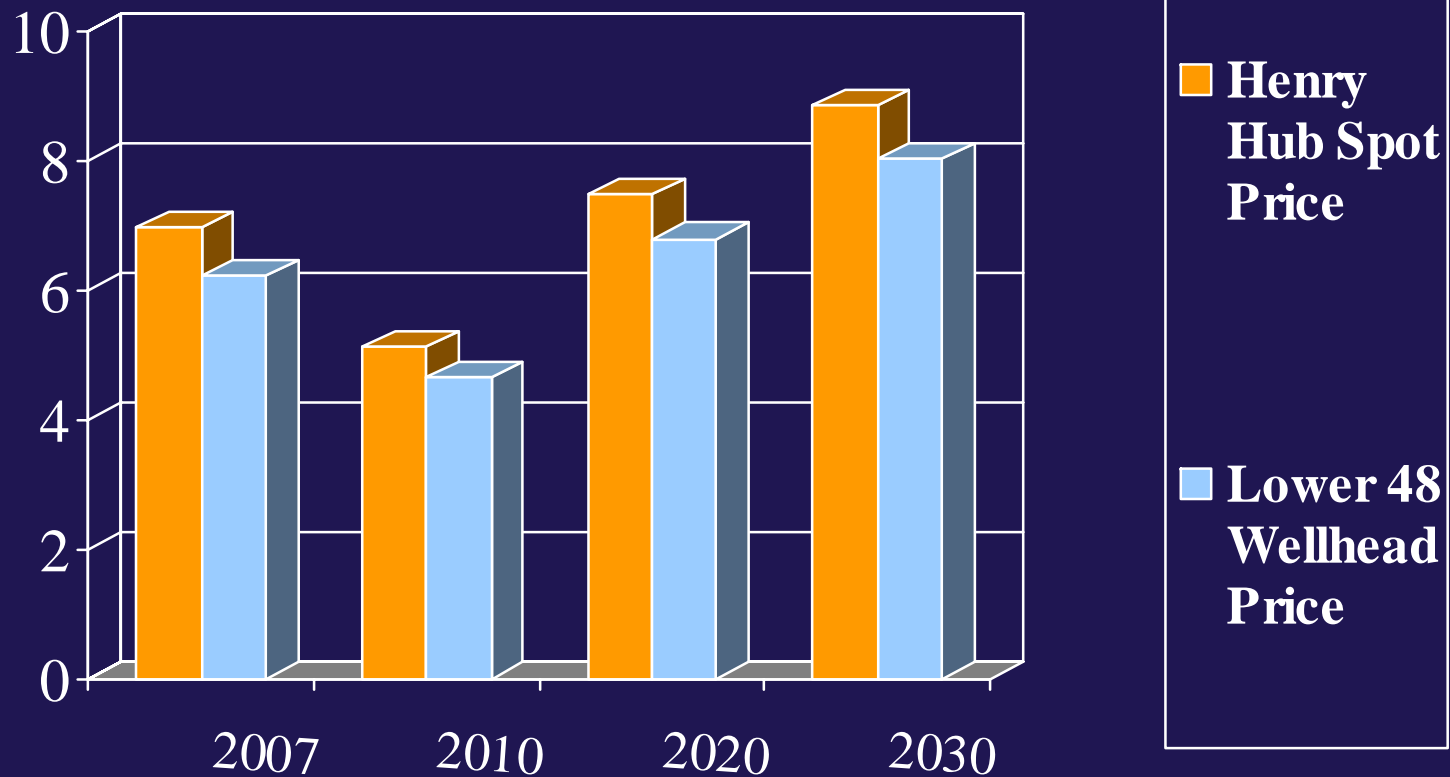


Natural Gas - 2006
